To access the task, click on the Assessment block in your Canvas course.

Listening: You will listen to THREE texts in FRENCH. You will respond in English to questions phrased in English based on the texts. You may listen to the audio as many times as you need, but you must allow enough time to complete all questions in the assessment within the 40-minute time limit.

Reading: You will read THREE texts in FRENCH and respond in English to questions phrased in English based on the text.

Instructions:

- Select a suitable time during school hours (8:30-3:30) from Monday 27 to Friday 31 May to
 complete the assessment. These dates can only be changed in exceptional circumstances and
 after consultation with the NSW School of Languages Department Head Teacher.
- The task is **timed**; once the assessment task is begun, students will have **40 minutes to complete and submit their answers** before access to the task is closed.
- Students will be allowed **ONE attempt only** to complete the task.
- Students will need to be in a quiet room, isolated from other students, with internet access to Canvas and a headset.
- Students are required to complete their responses in Canvas, for instance by selecting the correct response or typing their answers.
- The use of **print dictionaries** is permitted; however, students are **NOT** to access online dictionaries, other electronic devices, or external websites during the assessment.

You will need to show your ability to use the language covered up to Module 10 of the Year 10 course and include language covered in the Year 9 course.

Feedback provided

You will be assessed on how well you:

- identify and interpret information from a range of texts.
- evaluate and respond to information, opinions and ideas.

The teacher will provide written feedback outlining strengths and areas for improvement to build on knowledge, understanding and skills for future learning.
