Specifications

This paper will consist of three sections:

Section I – Understanding Texts – Analysing Texts – 10 marks

You will read two short texts in Latin. In Question 1, you will be required identify, explain, analyse or manipulate grammatical features of a text. In Question 2, you will be required to answer short comprehension questions based on one of the passages.

Section II – Understanding Texts – Translating Texts – 5 marks

In Questions 3 and 4, you will be required to translate two short passages from the prescribed text into English.

Section III – Intercultural Understanding – 5 marks

In Question 5, you will be required to answer questions to demonstrate your understanding of texts and their relationship to Ancient Roman culture.

NB: this task will focus on Chapters 1-11 of OLB I.
