

Advanced Standing/RPL is a strategy for students who have already achieved the outcomes of a previous year or stage. These students do not have to complete the work related to the Year for which advanced standing is granted, e.g. a Year 10 student taking a 200 hour Year 10 language without having done Year 9 (100 hours) in that subject; a student advancing into Year 12 without having done the Preliminary Course in that subject.

NB: In this case the student **is not awarded 2 Units for the Year 11 course not undertaken.**
