

Specific criteria for evaluation of progress of Extension students

Ability Working towards:

- Excellent oral skills in target language
- Excellent knowledge of grammar, spelling and vocabulary of target language (script if appropriate)
- Sophistication of English language evident
- Some understanding of the prescribed text
- Submitted work is of high quality
- Ability to complete and submit audio and written tasks online
- Good use of course materials when completing summative tasks related to the course

Participation

- Engaging in course
- Regular, prepared phone lessons
- Progressing through course work at expected rate
- Returns work regularly online and/or offline as required
- Shows maturity in approach/attitude
- Quick to respond to messages or suggestions

A decision will be made by the NSW School of Languages teacher, in consultation with the Head Teacher, on whether the student should:

- continue with the Extension course or
- continue provisionally with the Extension course and have a further review of his/her course progress at the end of Assessment Session 1 or
- review the advisability of continuing with the Extension subject or
- withdraw from the Extension Course at NSW School of Languages.

The home school Principal, Supervisor and student will be notified by the NSL Faculty Head Teacher in writing of the outcome of the review.
