Specifications:

Section I – Skills in Translating

- Question 1 (10 marks) will require a translation into English of **TWO** extracts totaling approximately 15 lines from Chapters 49-54 of *Oxford Latin Course III*.

Section II – Skills in Grammar Analysis

- Question 2 (10 marks) will consist of 20 short answer or multiple-choice questions about the grammar analysis of TWO extracts from Chapters 49-54 of *Oxford Latin Course III*.

Section III – Understanding Texts

- Question 3 (10 marks) consists of a series of short-answer questions about ONE of the verse passages in Chapters 49-54 of *Oxford Latin Course III*.
