Listening (20 marks) - 20%

You will hear **SEVEN** texts in ITALIAN based on the above topics. You will be required to respond in **English** to questions phrased in English. You will complete this assessment under supervision in your home school on the answer paper provided.

Speaking (20 marks) – 10%

Part A: You will be given three questions in Italian related to the relevant syllabus topics. You will be asked to choose one topic and answer one question relating to that topic. You will have 2 minutes to prepare your response. You will speak in Italian for one minute. You can make some written notes, but you must not read them. **Part B:** You will be shown some stimulus pictures related to the relevant syllabus topics. You will choose the pictures/topics you want to discuss. You will then engage in a 6–7-minute conversation based on your chosen pictures. You may not make notes during the task. You will complete this assessment online under supervision in your home school.
