## Listening (20 marks) – 20%

You will hear **SIX** texts in KOREAN based on the above topics. You will be required to respond in **English** to questions phrased in English. You will complete this assessment under supervision in your home school on the answer paper provided.

## Speaking (10 marks) – 10%

You will be required to engage in a 5-minute conversation about the relevant topics. You will complete this assessment online under supervision in your home school.

On the assessment day, you will be given questions related to the listed topics beforehand and will have 3 minutes to prepare. Students are not permitted to make any notes during the preparation time.

Students will begin the conversation with an introductory statement about the topic given. They should speak for about one minute after which the teacher will ask follow-up questions.

### Feedback provided

The teacher will provide written feedback outlining strengths and areas for improvement to build on knowledge, understanding and skills for future learning.
