### Specifications:

#### Listening (20 marks) – 20%

You will hear **seven** texts in MODERN GREEK based on the above topics. You will be required to respond in **English** to questions phrased in English. You will complete this assessment under supervision in your home school on the answer paper provided.

#### Speaking (10 marks) – 10%

**Part 1** You will be shown two stimulus pictures and accompanying questions. You will have 1 minute of preparation time to choose one image and to think about the questions provided. You will then engage in a 2-minute conversation with the examiner in which they will ask you the stimulus questions. You may not make notes during the task.

**Part 2** is a 3-minute conversation with the examining teacher on other topics you have covered in the course so far. You will complete this assessment online under supervision in your home school via Teams Meetings.

### Feedback provided

The teacher will provide written feedback outlining strengths and areas for improvement to build on knowledge, understanding and skills for future learning.
