Specifications:

Listening (20 marks) - 20%

You will hear **FIVE** texts in **PORTUGUESE** based on the above topics.

In **Part A**, you will be required to respond in **English** to questions phrased in English.

In **Part B**, you will be required to respond in **Portuguese** to questions phrased in English and in Portuguese.

You will complete this assessment under supervision in your home school on the answer paper provided.

Speaking (20 marks) - 10%

You will be asked two questions with follow-up questions.

You must first answer the questions by delivering a short monologue in Portuguese (approximately 2 minutes per question). The examiner will ask you follow-up questions after each question.

You will spend a total of approximately 5 minutes on each question. The entire task will last approximately 10 minutes.

You will complete this assessment online under supervision in your home school.
