

Application for Recognition of Prior Learning

Students with prior learning who can demonstrate that they have met the outcomes of a course without having studied it at NSW School of Languages (NSL), may receive credit for recognition of prior learning (RPL) so that they may enrol midway through a Stage. For example, a Year 10 student may study the Year 10 content of a Stage 5 language without having studied that language in Year 9; a Year 12 student may study the Year 12 content of a Stage 6 language without having studied that language in Year 11. These students do not have to complete the work related to the year for which RPL is granted.

Important: When granted RPL, a **Year 10 student will receive 100 hours only** (and not 100 hours for the Year 9 course not undertaken) and a **Year 12 student will receive 2 units only for the HSC course** (and not 2 units for the Year 11 course not undertaken).
