This document is required by NESA for the following Language courses and should be submitted with the application form:

- all Year 11 Beginner level courses
- Year 11 Chinese, Japanese and Korean Continuers courses
- Year 11 Chinese and Korean in Context courses.

How to use this form:

Please complete the Statutory Declaration, which must be signed by the student and an appropriately qualified person. It is an offence under the Oaths Act 1900 to make a false statutory declaration. Please note that the signing of a statutory declaration may also be witnessed by audio-visual link. Where this method is used, the witness should tick the box alongside the statement provided. If you are unsure of the information provided in your application, seek advice from your Principal before you sign the declaration.

The following persons may witness a statutory declaration in New South Wales:

- a justice of the peace
- a notary public
- a solicitor or barrister with a current New South Wales or interstate practising certificate
- a commissioner of the court for taking affidavits
- a person by law authorised to administer an oath.
