Students in NSW secondary and central schools may enrol to study a language course not available to them at their home school.

Subject to satisfying the guidelines, enrolment is available for Years 9 - 12 students from NSW public schools and other educational providers.

Learning is supported through a diverse program of online courses, speaking lessons, video conferencing and email.

Each term study days are held at NSW School of Languages where students enjoy the opportunity to meet and learn with other students and staff.

Stage 5

Through studying Stage 5 Latin, you can:

- Expand your vocabulary – a plethora of words from a variety of disciplines have their origin in Latin words - including philosophy, medicine, music, biology, science, and mathematics.
- Become familiar with many of the myths that have inspired modern drama from Harry Potter to Percy Jackson.
- Participate in International Competitions to challenge you and enhance your knowledge and skills.
- Improve your command of English grammar as well as your understanding of literary theory and devices. Much literary theory and as well as concepts are derived from classical literature.
- Learn what was the basis for the development of modern Romance languages – French, Italian, Portuguese, Spanish and Romanian – and in doing so be able to more easily learn those very languages.

We hold face-to-face lesson days each term, whether that be onsite or online, where you can meet other students equally enthused by their study of Latin.

Through studying Stage 6 Latin, you can:

- Study the great thinkers, poets and orators of the ancient Graeco-Roman world.

- Participate in International Competitions to challenge you and enhance your knowledge and skills.
- Understand the role and influence of the Latin tongue and Roman writers on modern literature and approaches to education.
- Immerse yourself in the pithy aphorisms (wise sayings) of Roman jurists, poets, orators and playwrights.
- Participate in Year 12 Latin Seminar Days with other high schools.
