Our School

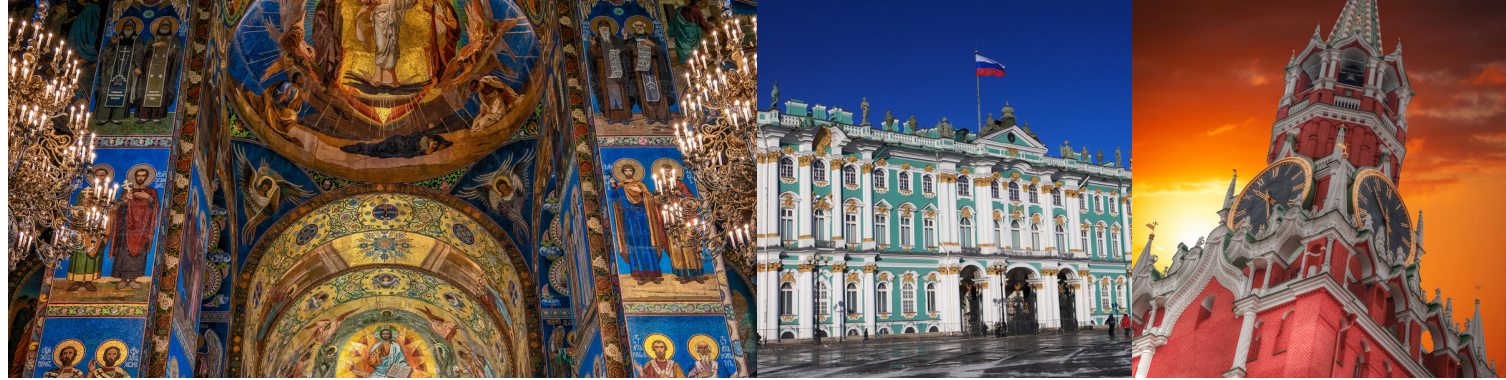
NSW School of Languages is a distance education language specialist school. We are part of a network of Department of Education schools that provide education to students by distance education.

Students in NSW secondary and central schools may enrol to study a language course not available to them at their home school.

Subject to satisfying the guidelines, enrolment is available for Years 9 - 12 students from NSW public schools and other educational providers.

Learning is supported through a diverse program of online courses, speaking lessons, video conferencing and email.

Each term study days are held at NSW School of Languages where students enjoy the opportunity to meet and learn with other students and staff.

Weekly speaking lessons are an integral part of the courses for students to develop their Russian speaking skills and to discuss the coursework with their teacher.

Years 11 and 12 students can only study the Russian Continuers course. This course is designed for students who have studied Russian in Years 9 and 10 or for those who have prior or background knowledge of Russian.

A range of authentic texts and media help students to develop their Russian language skills for the HSC examination.
