University Program in Focus

Macquarie University

Bachelor of Global Business with a major in Chinese-English Translation and Interpreting Bachelor of Global Business with a major in French Studies

Bachelor of Global Business with a major in German Studies

These programs have a compulsory placement as part of the core program, either overseas or with an international business operating locally.



Bachelor of Global Business with a major in Chinese-English Translation and Interpreting

Overview

This major has been created in partnership with the Beijing Language and Culture University (BLCU) in China. The program focuses on linguistic and cross-cultural aspects of achieving equivalence in translation and interpreting from Chinese into English and English into Chinese, plus translation practice involving translation from Chinese into English and English into Chinese of selected texts illustrating equivalence problems.

Key features

- expand and consolidate your writing and speaking skills in both languages and foster skills in mediation between both languages and culture
- opportunity to study with native Chinese speakers from the BLCU in Beijing who will be completing the major as part of a double qualification
- this major offers an articulation path into the Masters of Translating and Interpreting offered by the Department of Linguistics.



Bachelor of Global Business with a major in French Studies



Overview

The French major aims to give you proficiency in French language as well as an awareness of, and appreciation for, the societies and cultures of the Francophone world.

French units include:

- French language from introductory level to advanced
- culture and history of France developing a greater understanding of the language.

Key features

Study in France or other French-speaking countries, through University-run residential courses
or exchange agreements. Partner institutions include the Sorbonne in Paris, the University of
Bordeaux III and the University of Geneva in Switzerland.

Bachelor of Global Business with a major in German Studies

Overview

German Studies provides a sound knowledge of the German language and culture through:

- intensive language teaching
- a critical analysis of Germany's literature, history and culture.

German units are for beginners to advanced. They cover German language and its varieties in literature, film, history, culture and its major city Berlin.

Key features

- Travel scholarships are available for study in Germany, in a University-run course or under exchange agreements.
- Develop the level of complexity in speaking, listening, reading and writing German required for the Zertifikat C1, the upper-intermediate exam set by the Goethe-Institut. Held globally, this is recognised worldwide in business and education.
