Bachelor of International and Global Studies

ATAR Cut off for 2014: 92

Minimum course duration: 3 years full time

Overview

With an interdisciplinary social science approach, the degree's core units enable you to acquire varied perspectives on international and global dynamics informed by a wide range of social science standpoints. In your core major, you will focus on one of a specified range of relevant social science or area studies disciplines. You can choose how to complement your major from a wide range of subject areas across the University.

As the degree aims to develop skills relevant to international and intercultural contexts you will also be required to undertake language study from a very diverse range offered by the Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences. You will also gain a first-hand appreciation of the degree's core concerns through embarking on a semester of international exchange at a partner university, preferably in a country speaking your chosen language. This semester of exchange is a required component of the degree.

Structure – Major

What is a major?

A major is a specialisation in a chosen area of study and is designed to develop your knowledge and skills in a particular area. The Bachelor of International Global Studies requires that students complete a core major. You can complete a second major from the Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences or from another faculty in the University as permitted.
