#### ILLNESS/ MISADVENTURE APPEAL FORM

Information / Application for Assessment Task Misadventure

This form is to be submitted if you were/are unable to complete an Assessment Task due to an illness or misadventure.

#### You cannot submit an appeal on the basis of:

- difficulties in preparation or loss of preparation time including difficulties experienced computers
- alleged deficiencies in tuition
- long-term illnesses such as glandular fever unless you have suffered a 'flare-up' or ex
  of your symptoms during the exam/task period
- the same grounds for which you received special exam provisions unless you have exadditional difficulties during a task
- · misreading the exam or exam instructions

The illness / misadventure application is limited to matters pertaining to the conduct and preser the missed task only. Consequently, students may only appeal in relation to circumstances that immediately before the task in question. *Note*: A separate Illness / Misadventure appeal form completed for EVERY missed task and must be received within 5 school days after the due dat Assessment Task.


